Event	Description
Child Evaluations	Child Evaluations will be done by each child's primary caregiver and then given to the parents to take home. When they are done at the beginning of Spring and the end of the school year, they will be saved to look over with parents during a Parent/Teacher Conference.
Parent/Teacher Conferences	Parent/Teacher Conferences need to be done twice a year. At the beginning of the Spring Semester and at the End of the Year. This gives teachers the opportunity to connect with parents about their child's goals and milestones.
Class Parties	Class parties are planned for four holidays throughout the year. Parents are given the opportunity to donate treats (but do not have to) and also gives them a chance to participate in their child's classroom.
Spirit Week	We will do Spirit Week once in the Fall and once in the Spring. These are fun-filled weeks that get the parents, children, and teacher involved.
Back to School Night	Back-to-School Night will be a great chance to greet the new families and spend some time with our current families. Parents will visit with their child's classroom for the upcoming year and talk with teachers about what they can expect from the class.
Goodies for Grandparents	This is a fun way to get grandparents involved in the center as well. We will sit out sweet treats for any grandparent that visits and set up a space for them to spend time with their grandchildren at school.
Pumpkin Patch Field Trip	We will take the Pre-K class to Sinkland Farms for some outdoor fall activities and to pick out a pumpkin. We will also bring back pumpkins for the rest of the center.
